RE: Satisfaction of Southside Protection Zone replenishment obligation

Dear Governor Lewis:

In October 2019, the Arizona Department of Water Resources (ADWR) notified the Arizona Water Banking Authority (AWBA) that a replenishment obligation had been incurred in the Southside Protection Zones for water use in calendar year 2018 (enclosed). Based on its analysis, ADWR determined that a replenishment obligation of 9.78 acre-feet had been created in the Municipal and Industrial (M&I) Eastern Protection Zone South. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 45-2623(A), the AWBA must satisfy the replenishment obligation by June 1 of the third calendar year following the year the obligation was created, in this instance, 2021.

The AWBA acknowledged its requirement to satisfy this replenishment obligation in its 2020 Plan of Operation, proposing to extinguish an equal volume of long-term storage credits (LTSCs). This method may be used if the LTSCs were earned within the last seven years and the storage facility is located within the protection zone where the obligation was created. The AWBA satisfied this obligation on February 26, 2020, by extinguishing 9.78 acre-feet of LTSCs accrued at the Hohokam Irrigation and Drainage District groundwater savings facility from water stored in 2013.

The Water Planning and Permitting Division has completed its analysis of water use in the Southside Protection Zones. The focus of the analysis was to determine if there are any annual replenishment obligations as required under A.R.S. § 45-2622. Replenishment obligations were calculated for each of the following subsections:

- 45-2622.B.1 Municipal and Industrial Replenishment Obligation for the Western Municipal and Industrial Protection Zone
- 45-2622.B.2 Municipal Replenishment Obligation for the Western Municipal Protection Zone
- 45-2622.B.3 Municipal and Industrial Replenishment Obligation for the Eastern Protection Zone North
- 45-2622.B.4 Municipal and Industrial Replenishment Obligation for the Eastern Protection Zone South
- 45-2622.B.5 Irrigation Replenishment Obligation for the Western Municipal and Industrial Protection Zone and the Western Municipal Protection Zone
- 45-2622.B.6 Irrigation Replenishment Obligation for the Eastern Protection Zone North and the Eastern Protection Zone South
- 45-2622.B.7 Water Company Replenishment Obligation for the Eastern Protection Zone
- 45-2611 Transportation of Underground Water and Stored Water away from Eastern Protection Zones and Western Protection Zones
- 45-2626 Individual Replenishment Obligations for Industrial Use

Replenishment Obligation:

The analysis shows that there is a replenishment obligation of 9.78 AF for the 2018 reporting year in the Municipal and Industrial Eastern Protection Zone South.

Individual Obligation:

There is no individual replenishment obligation because the industrial use in the Eastern Protection Zone South failed to reach the 3.5 AF/acre threshold described in A.R.S. § 45-2626.B. Please see the table below for additional details.
