Availability of AWBA LTSCs for Firming CAP M&I Priority Subcontractors and Mohave County Water Authority

AWBA Quarterly Meeting March 22, 2023



Staff conducted two independent analyses regarding the estimated distribution of long-term storage credits (LTSCs):

- The ability of the AWBA to firm CAP M&I subcontractors (using LTSCs created with the water storage tax)
- The ability of the AWBA to firm Mohave County Water Authority (MCWA) (using LTSCs created with general fund monies)



AWBA LTSCs Available as of December 31, 2023

LTSCs created with the water storage tax:

- 1,582,453 AF in the Phoenix AMA
- 234,791 AF in the Pinal AMA
- 512,213 AF in the Tucson AMA

LTSCs created with general fund monies: 256,174 AF for MCWA
